

Ward Engineering and Land Surveying Ltd. has worked with Todd Smith of Western Tank & Lining Ltd. (WTL) based in Richmond, British Columbia, on several bolted steel potable water tanks between 2009 and 2013. In each case, components were delivered as scheduled and WTL crews constructed the tank correctly and on time. Within the limits imposed by other projects and crew travel requirements, Mr. Smith attempted to work around owner and project conflicts. Drawings stamped by a licensed British Columbia engineer were supplied as required by regulating authorities. Modifications such as increased snow load capacity and inlets designed to eliminate stagnant zones and improve circulation were provided.

Since the tanks were intended to be used for potable water, they were required to meet Interior Health Authority (IHA) requirements. IHA Waterworks Construction Permits were issued for these tanks. Completed tanks were leak tested and disinfected to AWWA specifications. Remaining issues, if any, were corrected in a timely manner.

In general, both the products and services provided to our clients by Western Tank and Lining Ltd. have been satisfactory.
